Education – E-learning at Govt. Schools

E-Learning at Government Schools is an initiative by Right To Live (Kote Foundation) in association with BYJU's (Think and Learn Pvt Ltd). This initiative is to offer students get access to graphically aided high-quality learning content that will contribute to better learning outcomes at Government schools in Karnataka.

Right To Live believes that more the learning is made intuitive and inspiring, the thirst for knowledge for the students will grow, thereby motivating them to study more and aspire to become responsible citizens of the country.

In January 2018 we piloted this program in 4 government schools in Bangalore. The program was a huge success and we received an overwhelming response from both students and teachers which motivated us to expand this high-quality learning facility to more and more government schools.

Today our e-learning program is active in 13 schools benefitting 1500 students daily!

Our E-Learning solution includes -

- 1. Providing digital infrastructure for the classroom which contains a 43" LED TV, Android tablet loaded with BYJUs contents, 4G internet connection & Chromecast.
- 2. Providing school coordinators who will be visiting the schools twice a week for the smooth implementation and monitoring of the program.
