Through this platform NGOs, volunteers, sponsors, and the Government are brought together with the sole purpose to uplift the standard of living and provide necessary help to those in dire need.

Key Activities Undertaken from Apr 2021 - Mar 2022

Right To Live mainly focuses on three major areas i.e. Health, Education and Basic Infrastructure. This year however, due to the on-going COVID-19 pandemic, we have also included 'Covid relief' as a key focus area.

HEALTHCARE



The Right To Live platform has been built to support the needy by giving them access to healthcare at an affordable cost. Under the Right To Live initiative, we take up the responsibility for Patient Care by raising donations using the Right To Live portal.

Patients Screening and Assessment









As part of the need assessment, we collect and review the financial and medical condition of the patient. This is carried out by employing one or more of the following methods - verification of the BPL card or Family Income certificate of the patients, medical treatment estimate, and case history provided by the hospital or doctor, and whenever necessary, we conduct home visits.

Trained professionals administer this activity by first verifying the case history and only then presenting the case to the managing committee. The committee takes it into consideration and comes to a decision to take up the case or dismiss it. Once approved, patient information is uploaded on the Right To Live website and is made visible to patrons.

From April 2021 to March 2022, we received a total of 53 applications from patients who were in dire need of medical care and support. These patients were referred by partner organizations, individual referrals, hospitals, and corporates. Out of 53 applicants, we were able to support 45 patients.

E-Learning at Government Schools

E-Learning at Government Schools is an initiative by Right To Live, in association with BYJU's (Think and Learn Pvt Ltd) and CLT (Children's LoveCastles Trust). This initiative is to provide students with graphically aided high-quality digital learning content that will contribute to better learning outcomes at Government schools in Karnataka.

Right To Live believes that once learning is made intuitive and inspiring, the thirst for knowledge for the students will grow, thereby motivating them to study more and aspire to become responsible citizens of the country.

Our mission is to bring more government school students closer to technology through E-learning and leverage it to improve learning methodologies and outcomes. **Our E-Learning program is now currently active in 51 Government schools in Karnataka and 5 schools In Tamil Nadu.**

Education Scholarship Programs

Right To Live recognizes the need to make quality education accessible to all. We identify students that hail from socio-economically underprivileged backgrounds and have an innate passion to pursue their studies.

We do a need assessment and present the profiles to the Trust, who then choose and hand out scholarships to the deserving students. We were delighted to note that a majority of the students who passed their second PUC have opted for engineering and other courses. Adding to this, many government school children have completed SSLC from the Right To Live intervention school.

From April 2021 to March 2022, we supported a total of hundred and five (105) children.

Laptop Donation

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, students all over the world were forced to move from physical classrooms to online/virtual ones. Not everyone in the rural areas has access to a phone or tablet for attending online classes. Right To Live addressed this problem by helping poor, underprivileged students of Government schools in Karnataka with no access to smartphones, laptops, desktops, tablets, or internet connection to attend their online classes.

From April 2021 to March 2022 we helped 75 such students, by collecting and donating used laptops (in working condition) from the following donors.

Wi-Fi network for schools in rural areas

The 21st century, which is often known for its advanced technological developments, still finds students facing obstacles to receiving a good education. Internet connectivity that is high-speed, continuous, and reliable is technically not viable in certain districts as the residences are on hilly terrains. Students are forced to climb up hills and travel long distances amidst the torrential rain to find network or connectivity.

Right To Live has taken the initiative to provide a steady and reliable Wi-Fi network for schools in rural areas. Additionally, students living nearby are also given access so that they can attend their online classes.



To set up this project, Internet Service Providers like BSNL would provide bandwidth, and OMEs would provide hotspot hardware and software. Students can access the network anywhere within 100 meters radius surrounding the school.

Computer Lab set up at Govt institutions



Right To Live partnered with Mindtree as well as other Corporates like Ocwen Financial Solutions Pvt Ltd, IBM, TCE, and Opteamix to set up computer labs in selected colleges by providing digital infrastructural support.

As part of the Partner's (donor's) social development program, the companies have donated 258 desktops to Right To Live with the intent to set up Computer Labs in Government PU Colleges and Polytechnic Institutions.

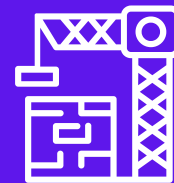
BYJU'S Tablet distribution in various Government Schools all over Karnataka

Right To Live's 1-to-1 remote mentoring program with the support of corporate employees helps government school students from the 8th-10th grade improve their digital and English communication skills through the usage of Byju's Tablets. Right To Live closely coordinates with school teachers and assigned mentors to ensure the effective usage of these devices.

Funding of INR 11,00,000 was raised by Opteamix, Amazon, Vistra Corporate Services, and individuals. A total of 130 tablets were distributed to Bagepalli Government Girls' High School, Bagepalli Taluk, Government High School, Sarjapur, and Govt High School Hebbagodi in Bengaluru.

RO Plant Installation

Most of the people of Bagepalli Taluk in Chikkaballapur District, drink contaminated water every day and thus are exposed to several water-borne diseases. Bagepalli taluk constitutes 228 villages (with a population of 1,83,498 people) and is considered one of the most backward regions in the state of Karnataka. Poor water quality in the region has been a prevailing issue in the Taluk. As a result, several children are suffering from dental fluorosis.

To address this prevailing issue, through multiple rounds of research, we identified the ideal location to install Reverse Osmosis Plants in a few villages within the Taluk. Right To Live has executed the two Reverse Osmosis Plant in Madapalli and Narayanswamy Kote villages in association with NASDAQ. Each RO plant can hold up to 1000 liters of water and will provide over 750 families and over 4000 people with clean drinking water.



2 Toilet Construction at Schools

Access to a functional and clean toilet is everybody's essential right. At the Sri Karibasavaswamy Vidyapeeta school in BG Pura, Malavalli Taluk, Mandya district, Karnataka, scarcity of funds made it impossible to build a toilet for school students that housed 250+ children, aged between 6 to 18 years. These children, due to the lack of facilities used neighboring open spaces to relieve themselves.

Right To Live, with the support of IBM employee contribution, constructed eight units of toilets (4 Boys and 4 Girls) to provide access to clean sanitation facilities for the children of the schools.



3 Foot Bridge Construction

Right To Live utilized Rs. 25,000 of the Opteamix Employee ECS donation as a contribution towards the construction of a bridge (GramaSetu) between Kamila-Mogra, of Guttigaru gram panchayat, Sullia, Dakshina Kannada.

Facilitating Access to Clean Drinking Water in Schools

Every child deserves clean drinking water—unfortunately, many Govt. Schools and colleges lack the facility to provide safe drinking water. Understanding this need, Nasdaq provided four RO Water purifiers as part of their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity.

Two Water Filters were given to Government Pre-University College, Basavanagudi. One was given to Govt school, Sarakki and another one to the mobile creche in the labourer colony of PESIT. This gift has helped close to a thousand students' who now have access to clean water.



GHS Thimmampalli and GHS Palyakere of Bagepalli Taluk, Chikkaballapur

Right to Live took upon the initiative to renovate these Government schools with the support of Microsoft employee's donation of over Rs 11,00,000. The following activities have been undertaken - concrete and churki laying for four rooms, 24 new windows, iron door fitted for Smart Classroom, toilet renovation (plumbing work with motor connection), churki for roof and flooring for corridor, iron Door and renovation of office, staircase and classrooms.



Murulya School Flooring – worth INR 62,000

Two classrooms of Government Upper Primary School, Murulya, Sullia, Dakshina Kannada now have a smooth vitrified tile floor. Kids need not struggle on the uneven floor anymore. Thanks to Opteamix employees who contributed through ECS donations to implement this project.



Sneha Shikshana Samsthe, Sullia

This is a non-profit organization working to upgrade the standard of education at the primary and high school level by introducing innovative pedagogy for creative learning. During the Covid times, the school was struggling to manage its operations, and Right To Live, with the help of Opteamix, donated INR 2,00,000 to help the school continue its selfless service to underprivileged children.



Supported house renovation at Aivarnadu

Janaki lives with her daughter-in-law Vasanthi and two grandchildren. Vasanthi works as a daily wage worker. Both Janaki and Vasanthi are struggling to make ends meet. In addition to this, their house was in a dilapidated state. The roof had to be dismantled due to the weak structure. Right To Live donated INR 15,000 to rebuild the roof of their home.

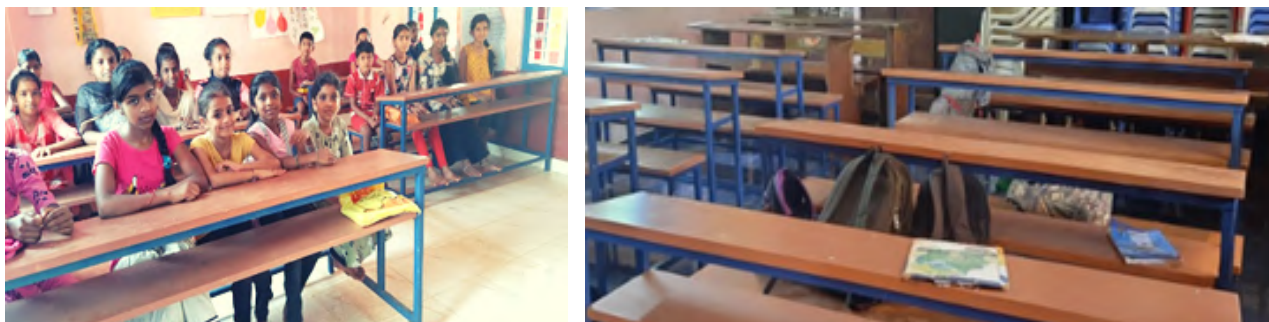
Provided a color printer for a Govt. PU College in Shantigrama

Provided desks and benches for students at Government schools

Guttigaru School



Guttigaru is a village in the Sullia Taluk of Dakshina Kannada district in Karnataka. It is a key area that has witnessed most of the educational projects of our organization. Right to Live in association with Microsoft provided 25 benches for the Guttigaru government school at Sullia.

Government Model Higher Primary School, Menase

GMH Primary School in Menase, Sringeri Taluk, Chikmagalur District, is around 80 years old. This prestigious government school has a record of the highest number of students in Sringeri taluk, with a total of 320 students from the nursery classes to the 8th standard.

Due to the absence of benches and desks, students from kindergarten to 3rd standard sit on the floor. As a result, the children are prone to falling ill due to the cold weather (owing to geographical location) and the poor infrastructural conditions of the school. With the help of the Vistra fund, Right To Live provided 50 desks to this school.

Bidar in North Karnataka is considered one of the backward regions of Karnataka. Right To Live targets to ensure basic facilities (like desks to sit, good boards in every classroom, separate toilets, and access to clean drinking water) are available in all the government schools that are associated with us through our e-learning programs. Right To Live had done due diligence and had identified there are no sufficient bench-desks available. With the CSR grant from Central Data Systems Pvt Ltd (CDS) 55 bench-desks to Government High School, Kallur, and Bhavani Nutan Higher Primary School in Humnabad Taluk, Bidar District.

Supported various Government schools with green boards

School education is synonymous with the blackboard. Education without blackboards cannot be imagined, even in this digital age. Unfortunately, many rural government schools lack basic furniture and fixtures, including blackboards. Boards at many schools are not in usable condition.

Understanding the need, Right To Live donated 12 green boards to four rural Govt schools in Humnabad, Bidar, North Karnataka. Further, four green boards were given to a Govt. High school in Gulur, Bagepalli, two to a Govt PU college, Shantigrama, Hassan and four to a Govt Junior College, Chikmagalur.



Provided learning materials & science working models

Right To Live and Ocwen Financial Solutions Pvt. Ltd continues to empower rural school students. We distributed learning materials & science working models to the Government Model Higher Primary school, Menase in Sringeri, Chikmagalur.



Distributed school bags and uniforms to Government School Children

With support from Ocwen, Nasdaq and the employees of Microsoft, Right To Live distributed school bags and stationery items to over 900 children from different government schools under Kothakote Grama Panchayat, Bagepalli, Chikkaballapur, GHS Gulur, Government Model Higher Primary school, Menase in Sringeri, Chikmagalur and Divine Mercy Orphanage in outskirts of Bangalore. Also, t-shirts, pants and jackets, were distributed to all 300+ students from KG to 8th standard of GMHPS Menase.

COVID-19 relief during the Second Wave

Setting up of Rural COVID First Aid centers

At the onset of the second wave, Right To Live partnered with **Dr. Anil Kumar**, a General & Laparoscopic Surgeon operating a non-profit hospital at Bagepalli Taluk (in Chikkaballapur District, Karnataka), who has been working tirelessly in the remote parts of Karnataka. Dr. Anil formed teams of young volunteers in Bagepalli and Gudibande Taluks of Chikkaballapur to carry out daily checks for at-risk persons, the aged, and people with comorbidities.

The main objectives of these First Aid centers are to:

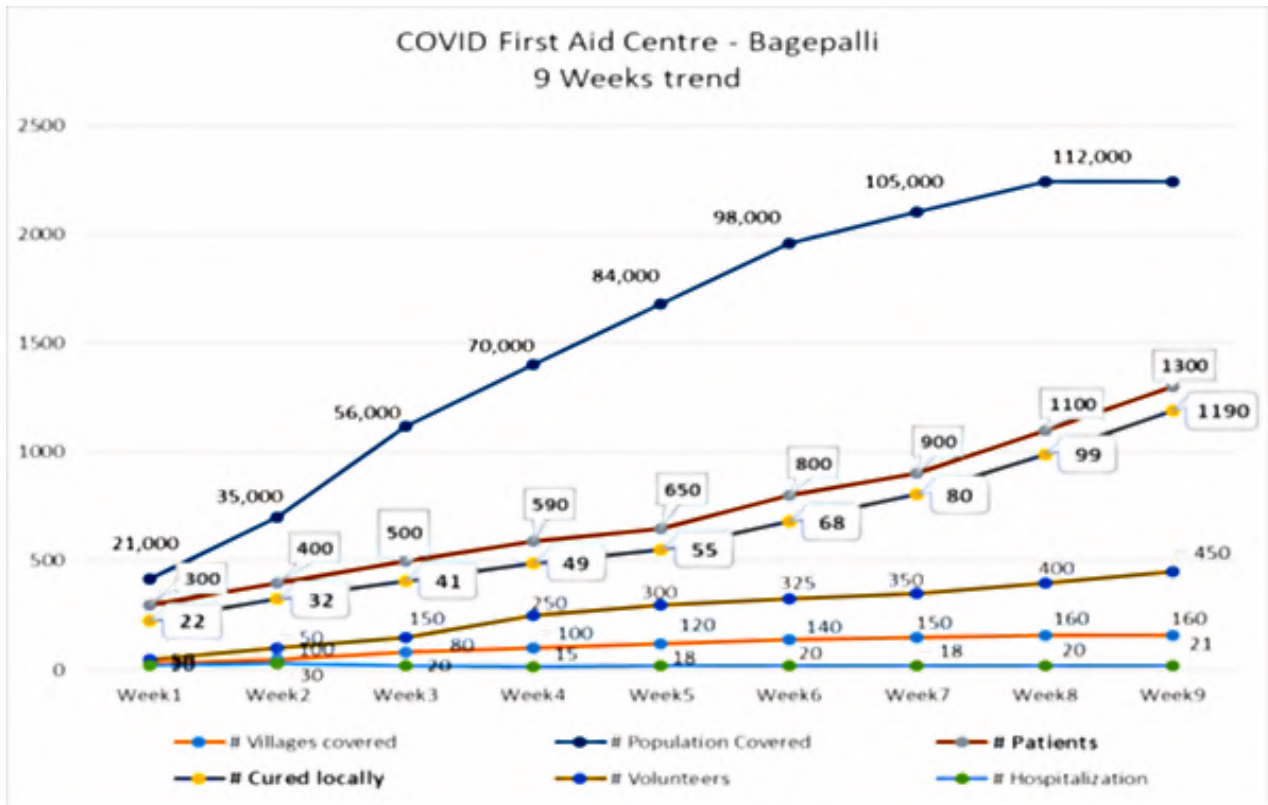
- Bring awareness to the villagers.
- Identify those who are showing COVID-19 symptoms.
- Provide free medication to prevent further deterioration of their health condition.

Right To Live, in association with Rotary Spandana, along with support from corporates such as Ocwen Financial services, Pierian Services Pvt. Ltd. has donated several necessary medical equipment and consumables to these First Aid Centers. **More than 1,00,000 villagers from over 160 villages were covered by this project.**

Right To Live had also procured the HELOXYN monitoring equipment designed at the IIT Research Park Chennai, enabling Dr. Anil Kumar to monitor the in-patient's vital parameters like temperature and SPO2 levels remotely.



Cerner India's product CovSafe, a mobile application, was selected by Right To Live to record the patient's vital parameters with the help of the volunteers through their smartphones. In doing so, the patient's data was always available to the doctor, avoiding delay in taking precautionary measures.



Through the intervention provided by these Covid First Aid Centers, the percentage of hospitalized patients reduced from 7% to less than 2% within a few weeks.

The total infected cases were just about 1,300, and the numbers hospitalized were just 20. No single death was reported from these villages during the second wave, thanks to the intervention.

Supporting children impacted by COVID-19

The Pandemic has been devastating for students hailing from low-income families - from being forced to drop out of school due to lack of infrastructure to losing family members to COVID-19. Right To Live is trying to lessen the load on these students and their parents who have lost their livelihoods by helping such families with funds for Covid-related treatment, and medicines.

Right To Live reimbursed hospitalization charges, and gave a one-time grant of up to a limit of INR 25,000/- per family, where one, or both the parents or the earning member of the family, was affected by Covid-19. Additional support was given to 36 Students by paying pending school/college fees (amounting to Rs. 9,44,962).



Further, Right To Live referred 13 Covid-affected students to the E&Y Education Scholarship Program which financially supports students throughout their graduation with Rs 50,000 every year.

Providing Medical Equipment to Rural Government Health Centers

In many of the rural areas in India, the medical infrastructure is practically non-existent, except for an occasional private medical practitioner and poorly managed Public Health Centers. This project is a part of Right To Live's effort to equip rural and Government hospitals with the critical medical infrastructure required for Covid treatment and more.

With a fund of Rs. 52,87,985 Right To Live provided O2 Concentrators, Ventilators, BiPaP, Multi Para Monitor, Haemotology Analyser, Emergency crash cart with a trolley, and other equipment that the hospitals require.



This was carried out with the support of **Wipfli, Akamai, Vistra Corporate Services and Deccan Herald & Prajavani**, and individuals. Right To Live has provided support to the following 18 hospitals so far:

Support Idhayangal Charitable Trust to Save Type 1 Diabetes Children

Fund released: INR 12,18,746

Idhayangal Charitable Trust (ICT), a partner with Right To Live, works in treating poor children suffering from Type - I Diabetes. ICT aims to let no poor child with Type 1 diabetes suffer or die for want of funds or support to buy insulin, consumables, insulin pumps, or to receive an education.

The children range between 1-18 years and need insulin injections four times per day. Sub-optimal diabetes control at a young age leads to kidney failure, blindness, and death at a young age. However, proper glucose control, regular blood and urine investigations, close follow-up, and proper insulin treatment will enable such children to lead normal healthy lives.

Currently, ICT supports close to 300 children from underprivileged families and the numbers are increasing exponentially every month. Right To Live helped ICT by providing such life-changing insulin pumps to several underprivileged Type 1 diabetic children.



Distribution of N95 masks to SSLC students

Fund released: INR 20,000

In July 2021, lakhs of students in Karnataka appeared for their SSLC examinations. During that time, it was absolutely necessary to take precautionary measures to ensure the safety and security of the children at exam centers.

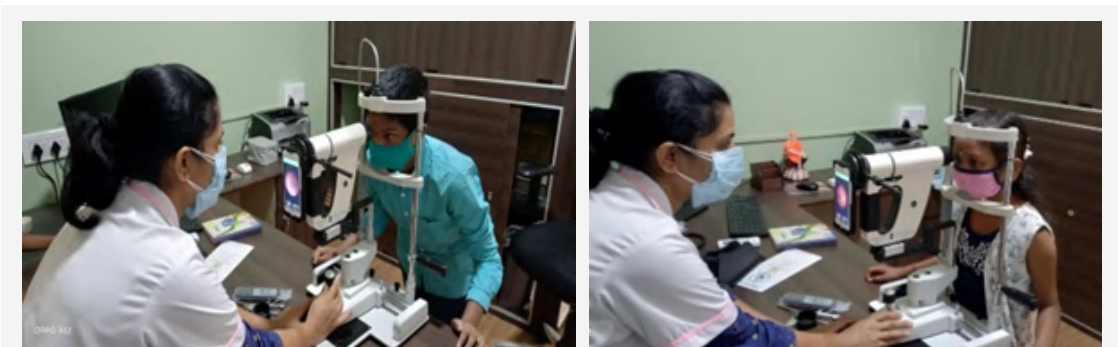
To ensure the safety of every child appearing for the exam, Right To Live in association with Rotary Bangalore Spandana, Rotary District Literacy team and Rotary Disease Prevention team provided close to 1.4 lakhs of N95 face masks to the children appearing for the examinations in rural areas of RID 3190 limits.



Helped set up a Diabetic Retinopathy (DR) Vision Center

Fund released: INR 67,005

One in three diabetics suffers from Diabetic Retinopathy, wherein a patient has severe damage in the blood vessels of the retina. This is caused by high levels of sugar in the blood. Very often, it goes undetected and can lead to complete and permanent loss of vision. Right To Live, in association with Rotary Bangalore Spandana, Rotary Galaxy, and Rotary AB Foundation (RABF) raised funds to set up the DR Vision Center.



Supporting Bengaluru's 'Doctor on Wheels'

Fund released: INR 9,03,568

Dr. Sunil Kumar Hebhi, the founder of the Matru Siri Foundation, provides free health services by organizing medical camps in vulnerable areas. He has been running a mobile clinic for the past eleven years in rural areas with the objective of providing medical care to the underprivileged. After the onset of the Pandemic, he stepped up his efforts to help those without immediate access to medical care. **He has now served in more than 7000 medical camps and provided free of cost covid treatment to almost 200 patients.**



Right To Live has extended a helping hand by providing a mobile van to Dr Hebhi, which would immensely assist him in his noble endeavors. The Maruthi EECO Ambulance van, sponsored by Wipfli, contains Primary Health Care equipment to facilitate the primary treatment of the underprivileged in and around Bangalore. Dr. Sunil conducted several camps starting Jan '22 with the mobile van donated by Right To Live.

Following are some of the areas where camps are conducted.

- Venkata village near Yelahanka: For general health check-ups
- Betthalasura village: Conducted a health camp for 50 slum children
- Mattikere and 4 villages in Vijayapura: Health camps
- Bagepalli Taluk: Conducted a 3-day medical camp in the govt schools for almost 360+ kids

Conducted Health Camps for School Students

In collaboration with Cerner Charitable Foundation, Right To Live conducted free health check-up camps for around 400 school children from Thimmampalli, Marganakute & Gulur Government High Schools near Bagepalli in Chikkaballapur.

Our Team used the Cerner App for data collection and better follow-ups of children who require further treatment. Special thanks to Dr. Sunil Hebbi & Cerner Corporation volunteers for facilitating the medical camp.

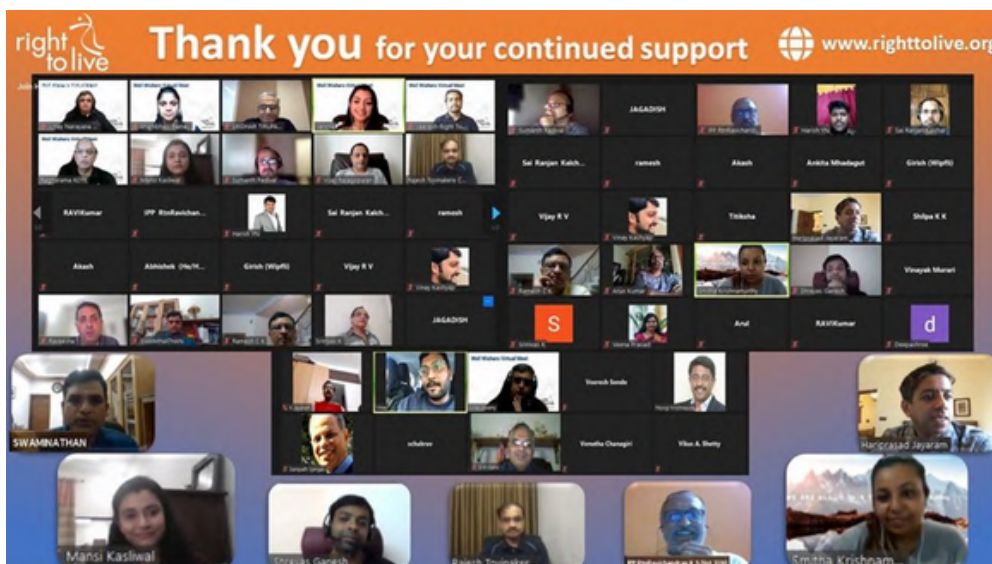

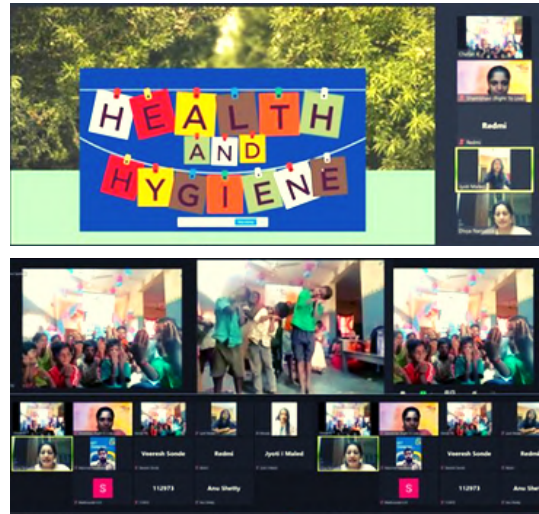
Corporate Employee Volunteering

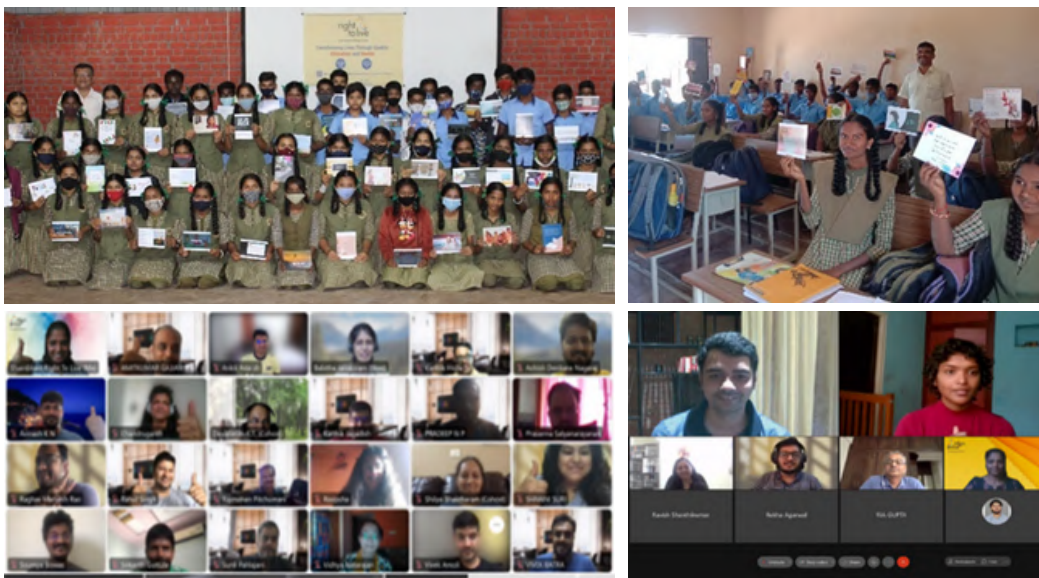

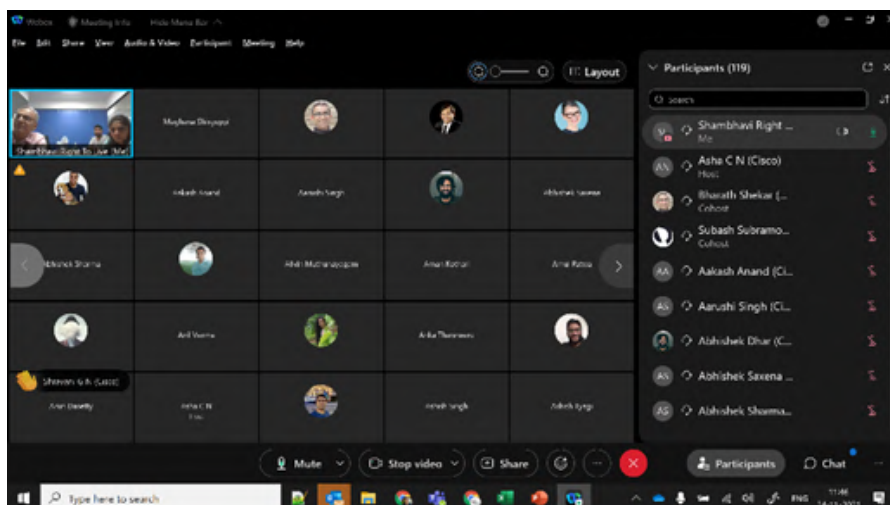
Partnering with McKinsey & Company for Volunteering Activities

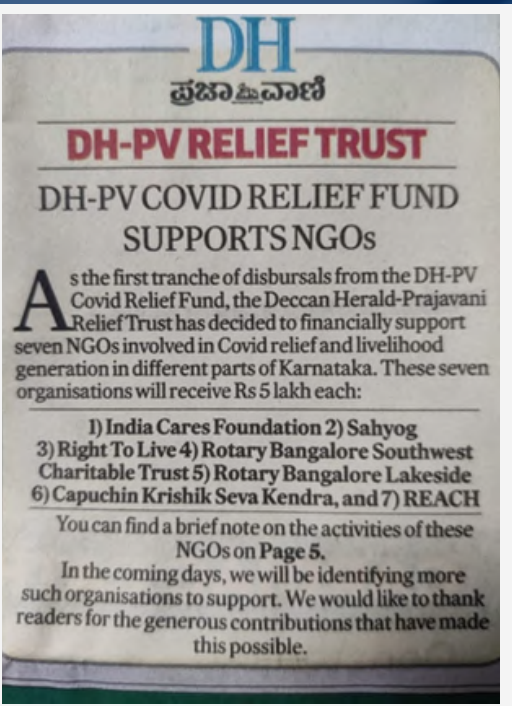

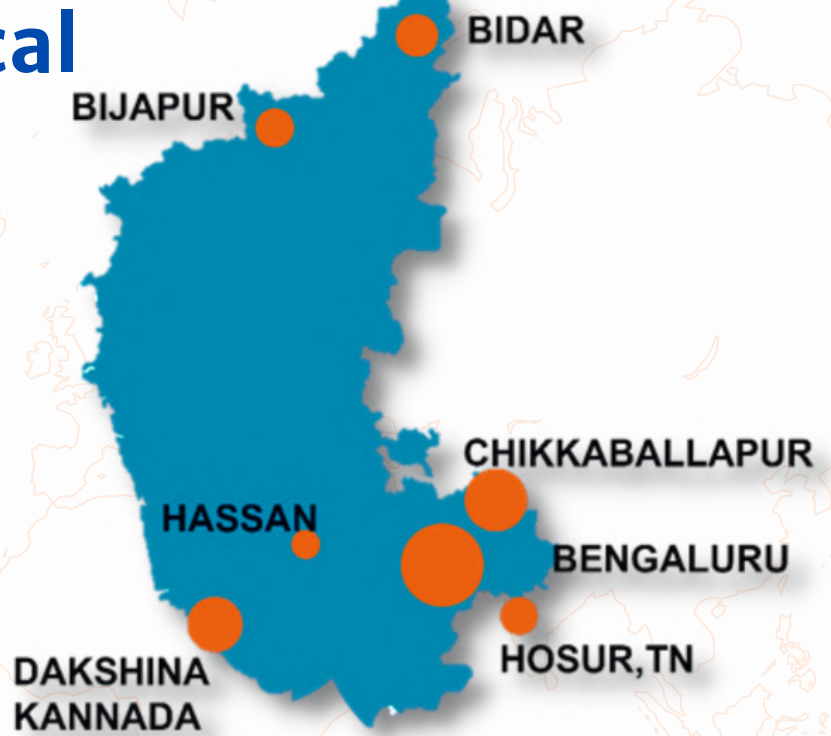
