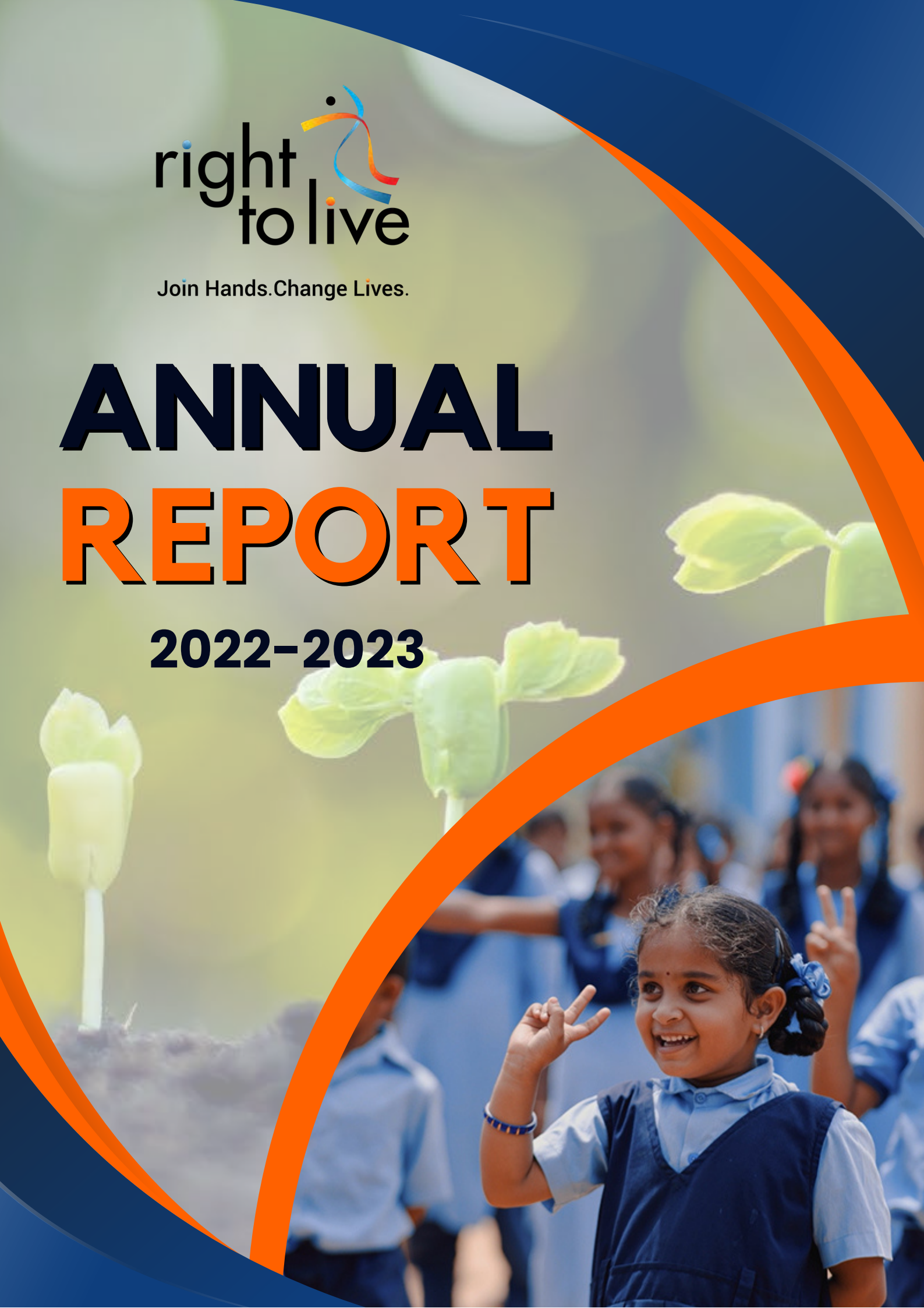

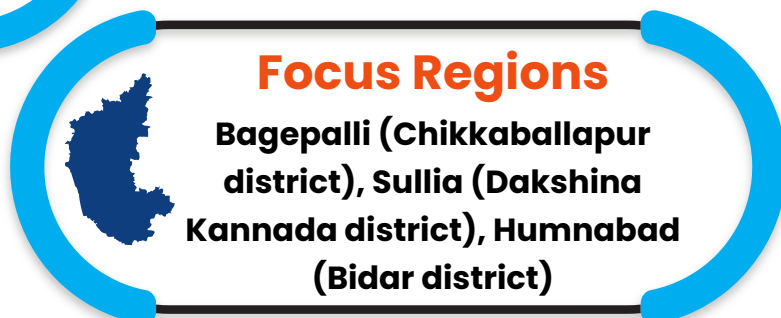
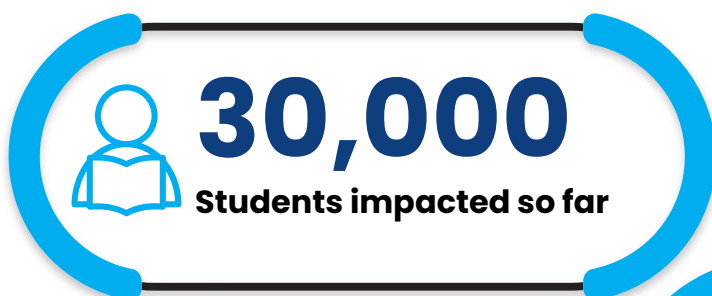

Corporates joined our efforts in the past year

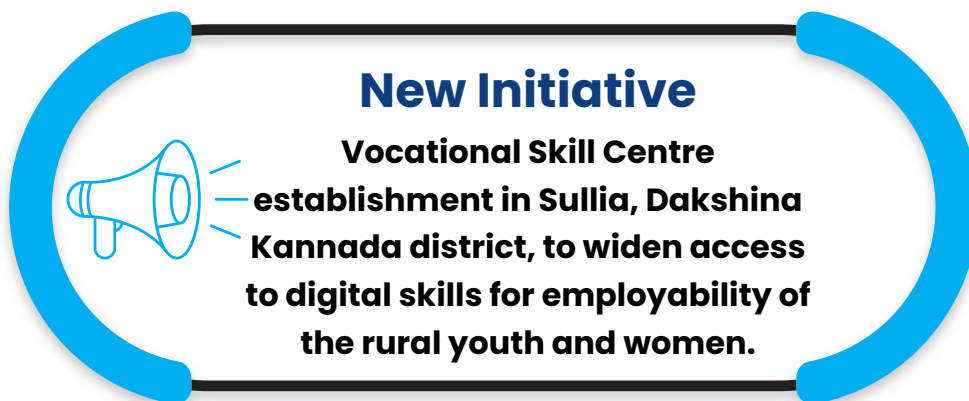


Total donation amount received in Rupee



School Digitization & Improvement, Higher Education and Skill Upgradation, Well-being and Healthcare

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

School Digitization

The digitization of education is crucial in India, where many institutions still lack the necessary tools to create engaging and up-to-date learning environments. It is essential to equip children, including those in rural government schools, with the technical skills required for the global workspace. By bridging the digital skills gap and enhancing technical competencies among rural students, India can ensure they are prepared for the future.

Smart Classrooms at Government Schools

- Right To Live, in collaboration with BYJU's (Think and Learn Pvt Ltd) and CLT (Children's Lovecastles Trust), provides visually aided high-quality digital learning content to students.
- This initiative aims to enhance learning outcomes and facilitate a better understanding among students.
- Right To Live's mission is to bridge the technology gap for government school students by introducing digital learning and utilizing it to improve learning methodologies and outcomes.
- In the fiscal year 2022-23, the program successfully implemented 38 Smart Classrooms in government schools across Karnataka.
- Notable corporate partners, including NASDAQ, Blackhawk Network, Aditi Consulting, IBM, Oracle Cerner, and Hewlett Packard, have joined forces for this initiative.





Computer Labs at Government Educational Institutions

- Many students in government schools and Pre-University Colleges (referred to as PUC) are first-generation users of digital devices and often experience fear when learning and using them.
- The establishment of computer labs has bridged the digital and infrastructural divide between privileged private schools and underprivileged government school students.
- This program aims to provide children with access to Digital First Technologies, enabling them to enhance their digital literacy skills.
- In the past year, Right To Live has successfully set up a total of 19 computer labs in government educational institutions.
- Right To Live has partnered with corporates such as WS Atkins, Hewlett Packard, Vistra Corporate Services, Walmart Global Tech India, Novozymes, Infogain, and Opteamix to establish computer labs in identified colleges.



Digital Upgradation of Government Schools

- As part of the UST Global Welfare Foundation's Adopt a School Program, Right To Live undertook the Digital Upgradation initiative for 8 rural government schools in various districts of Karnataka.
- The selected government schools and colleges received a total of 6 projectors, 10 desktops, 3 UPS, and a printer to enhance their digital capabilities.
- In collaboration with Mandaara Kannada Koota and Aniketana Vedike, Right To Live provided 52 projectors to government schools in Gundlupet, Chamarajanagar district.



School Improvement

Poverty and economic deprivation hinder children's participation in schools, necessitating special interventions to promote better attendance. Increased access to schooling facilities has positively impacted the number of school-going children from low-income households.

Toilet construction at Government schools

Access to clean and hygienic toilets is crucial, especially for girls in rural areas, to encourage continued education. Most government schools, especially, in rural areas, do not have access to or have an insufficient number of toilets which puts them at a high health risk.

Most are in an unkept condition or with broken doors, locks, etc. In the absence of adequate facilities, the students use neighboring open spaces to relieve themselves.

- Right To Live constructed toilets in 12 Government schools and renovated existing ones.
- Corporate donors like NASDAQ, individual donors like Devanand Jayaraman, and Microsoft employees contributed to providing clean toilets.





Library set-up

- School libraries are essential for education and specialized learning, providing dynamic information and fostering knowledge-based societies.
- Right To Live set up 8 libraries in Government educational institutions.
- Partnerships with Corporates like Walmart Global Tech India, Oracle Cerner, and Opteamix supported this initiative.



Provided desk-benches

Access to quality education remains a significant concern in rural government schools in India, where inadequate infrastructure forces children to sit on the floor during lessons.

- To address this issue, Right To Live provided 368 desk benches to identified schools in different districts of Karnataka.
- The necessary infrastructure was made possible through the support of various donors, including SLK Software, Blackhawk Network, Peepal Design, and Walmart Global Tech India.



School Bag Distribution

Poverty and economic deprivation necessitate special interventions to encourage greater participation of children in education. Improved access to schooling facilities has resulted in an increase in the number of children from low-income households attending school.

- Right To Live, in the past 1 year, provided school bags to 2073 underprivileged students from the Government schools of Karnataka.
- Corporate donors like Walmart and AppDynamics played a crucial role in providing the bags.





Facilitating access to clean drinking water in schools

Children from government schools in India often do not have access to clean drinking water. There have been many cases of children falling sick after having water from hand pumps or other contaminated water resources.

Right To Live in association with other partners has provided water purifiers to Chandra English High School, Rajajinagar, Government Polytechnic College, Channasandra and Bhavani Nutan Higher Primary School in Humnabad taluk.



Green Boards

- Green boards offer better visibility and facilitate interactive learning.
- Right To Live provided 4 green boards at Bhavani Nutan Higher Primary School in Humnabad taluk of Bidar district with support from Central Data Systems (CDS).



Higher Education and Skill Upgradation

The core vision of Right To Live is to provide education that enhances skills and develops the personality of beneficiary students. The initiative aims to bring out the best in unemployed youth, particularly women in rural and remote areas, by equipping them with essential digital skills and empowering them to create a bright future for themselves.

Education Scholarship Program

- The scholarship program by Right To Live aims to offer financial assistance to students from underprivileged communities who require support.
- By providing this financial aid, the program encourages talented and deserving students to excel in their education, become responsible members of society, and create financially sustainable and fulfilling futures for themselves.
- In the past year, Right To Live conducted a need assessment and awarded scholarships worth INR 14,92,795 to 186 deserving students.



1-to-1 Student Employee Mentorship Program

- Government school students, predominantly from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, often lack parental support and motivation to assist them in their studies.



- To address this gap, Right To Live has implemented a 1-to-1 remote mentoring program, specifically designed for government school students in grades 8 to 10. This program focuses on enhancing their soft skills and communication abilities.
- In the past year, 24 corporate employees from Byju's and 79 corporate employees from Oracle Cerner partnered with Right To Live for several months, actively participating in the 1-to-1 employee-student mentoring program.

Training on Soft Skills and Presentation Skills

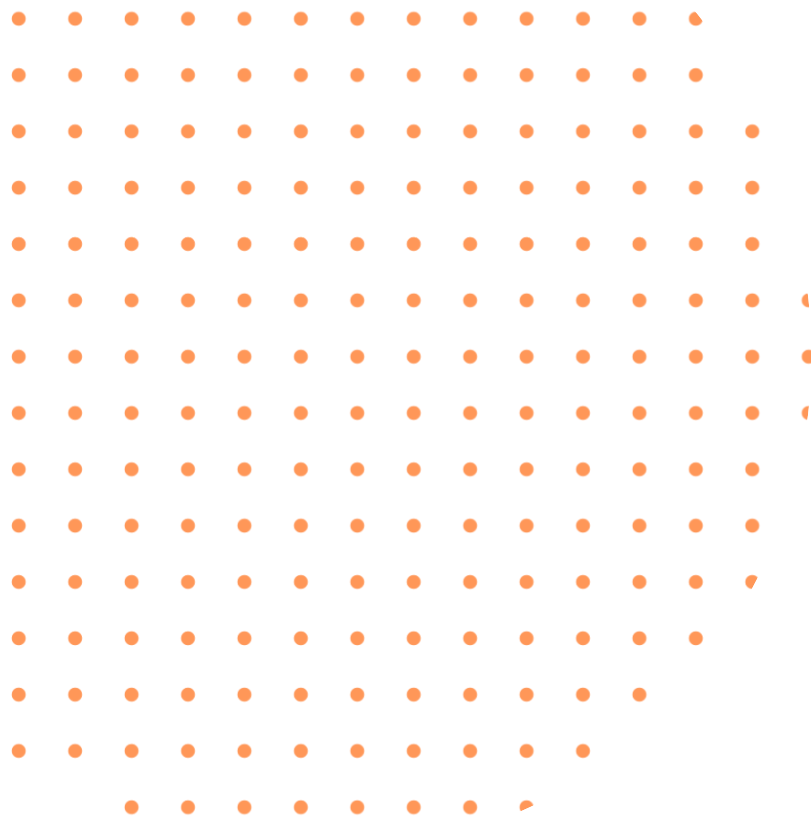
- Ten corporate employees from IBM interacted with over 60 students from Government Polytechnic College for Women, KR Circle, Bangalore, to provide soft skills training.
- The training sessions aimed to develop character traits, enhance interpersonal skills, and complement the hard skills required for the workplace among these young students.





Career Guidance and mentoring

- The objective of this program was to offer valuable guidance to high school students concerning their higher education and career prospects.
- Volunteers from Cisco generously contributed their time, talents, and experiences to mentor and provide guidance to 10th and 12th-grade students in the identified school.





Vocational Training Centre – Sphurtti Skill Development Centre Sullia, DK District

- India's growing economy demands technicians of international standards to fulfill the increasing demand for skilled manpower in various industries.
- In response to the issue of unemployment, particularly among rural youth and women, Right To Live, in collaboration with Sneha Shikshana Samsthe, Sullia, has established a Vocational Training Institute in Sullia, Dakshina Kannada district of Karnataka.
- The establishment of this Skill Centre has been made possible through the generous contributions from employees of Opteamix India Business Solutions.
- The pilot batch consisted of 15 students from low-income families who received training in Basic Computer Applications, Desktop Publishing (DTP), and Tally.
- Impressively, 73% of the students secured employment as computer teachers in colleges, assistants at Grameena Janaseva Kendra (Rural Welfare Association), and in data entry and bill generation roles.



Well-Being and Healthcare

Right To Live is dedicated to promoting the welfare and healthcare of both for the Community and for individuals. Our projects aim to address the diverse concerns and issues prevalent in society. Through our work, we strive to make a positive impact and bring about meaningful change for the betterment of the community.

Installation of RO Water Treatment Plants

- In the peri-urban area of Bagepalli taluk in Chikkaballapur district, Karnataka, serious concerns have arisen in recent years. With over 80% of the groundwater contaminated and unfit for drinking due to high fluoride and dissolved salt content, the health and environment of the community have been adversely affected.
- In response, Right To Live, with support from Trelleborg and individual donor Mrs. Sudha Janardhan, has successfully installed three Reverse Osmosis plants in Bagepalli during the year 2022-23.
- These plants aim to provide clean and safe drinking water, mitigating the health and environmental hazards faced by the community.



Health Camps

- India has limited healthcare infrastructure to cater to the needs of a vast and growing population, especially underprivileged and rural communities.
- In light of this, Right To Live has been able to successfully conduct health camps for 2500 BBMP pourakarmikas, with the support from our kind corporate partners UST Global Foundation and Himalaya Wellness Company.



Eye check-up Camps

- Eye Camps are highly effective in providing eye care services to a large number of people within a short period of time. These camps are organized in collaboration with the local administration and are completely free for the patients.
- The primary objective of these camps is to raise awareness about eye health and provide essential services such as eye check-ups and medical care.
- Right To Live, in partnership with its healthcare partner, has successfully conducted 16 eye-screening camps across various districts of Karnataka, including Bengaluru.
- These camps have benefited a total of 2000 individuals, with 723 people receiving spectacles to improve their vision. Additionally, 12 surgeries were performed for individuals with critical eye conditions, ensuring they receive the necessary medical intervention. Through these eye camps, Right To Live is working towards promoting eye health and providing accessible care to those in need.



Financial Support to underprivileged patients

- From April 2022 to March 2023, Right To Live received numerous applications from patients in critical need of medical care and support. These patients were referred by various individuals, partner organizations, corporates, and hospitals.
- In response to these urgent requests, Right To Live extended its support to 32 patients. With the generous contribution of INR 22,56,062 from Vistra Corporate Services and individual donors, the organization was able to provide the necessary financial assistance to these patients. This support helped cover their medical expenses, ensuring they received the required treatment and care.
- Through these efforts, Right To Live continues to make a significant impact in the lives of individuals facing medical challenges, providing them with hope, support, and a chance at a healthier future.

Distribution of Insulin/Glucometers for underprivileged diabetic children

- Idhayangal Charitable Trust (ICT) is a registered trust based in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu. As Right To Live's healthcare partner, ICT focuses on serving underprivileged children in India who are suffering from insulin-requiring Type 1 diabetes.
- In collaboration with ICT and with the generous support from Life For a Child, Australia Right To Live has undertaken an initiative to provide glucometers to 952 children. These glucometers are vital devices that help children monitor their blood glucose levels, enabling them to manage their condition effectively.
- By equipping these underprivileged children with glucometers, Right To Live and ICT are making a significant difference in their lives. This support empowers the children to monitor their health, ensuring timely intervention and better management of their Type 1 diabetes.





EVENTS CONDUCTED

TCS W 10K Marathon

The TCS World 10k Marathon in Bengaluru is a highly esteemed marathon event held in India. Right To Live, participating for the first time, used this platform to promote the digitization of government schools in rural areas of Karnataka and sought support from donors to make a positive impact.

Corporate partners like Opteamix and Ocwen collaborated with Right To Live in May 2022, joining hands to run for the cause and make a difference in the lives of underprivileged individuals. It was a privilege to have their support in this initiative.

Through their participation in the marathon, Right To Live raised close to 7 lakhs, contributing towards the advancement of digitization efforts in government schools. This amount will help improve the educational environment and opportunities for students in rural areas, enabling them to access better learning resources and technologies.



Annual Well-Wishers Meet

In August 2022, Right To Live organized a 'Annual Well-Wishers Meet' as an expression of heartfelt gratitude towards all corporate partners, associates, volunteers, and well-wishers who have been actively collaborating with the organization. This event provided an opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate the trust and support extended by these amazing individuals and organizations from around the world.

The collective efforts and contributions of these supporters have played a significant role in enabling Right To Live to make a lasting impact and achieve measurable outcomes for the communities they serve. The annual meet served as a platform to appreciate and applaud the invaluable support provided by all the stakeholders, highlighting their crucial role in the organization's endeavors.

Wish Tree (Daan Utsav)

The Wishtree program by Right To Live provides an opportunity for privileged individuals to fulfill the wishes of children from underserved sections of society. As part of this initiative, an annual Wishtree Distribution Event is organized, which serves as a corporate platform for wish fulfillment.

To facilitate this, a Wishtree was set up at the Opteamix office, and funds raised through this initiative were utilized to purchase the desired items for the children at Sampattu Orphanage in Bengaluru. In November 2022, employees from Opteamix gathered at the identified orphanage for the Wishtree distribution event. This event not only brought joy to the children by fulfilling their wishes but also fostered a sense of compassion and connection between the privileged individuals and the underserved community.





VOLUNTEERING

Right To Live recognizes the importance of volunteering and the positive impact it can have on worthwhile causes, people in need, and the wider community. Throughout the year, Right To Live organizes volunteering activities specifically for the employees of its Corporate Partners. These activities provide an opportunity for the employees to contribute their time, skills, and efforts towards various social initiatives and projects undertaken by Right To Live.

These volunteering activities not only benefit the beneficiaries of Right To Live's programs but also create a sense of social responsibility and awareness among corporate employees. It promotes a culture of giving back to the community and encourages individuals to actively participate in social causes.

Spreading JOY! Distribution of motivational/inspirational cards/posters

The program aims to uplift the morale of Government school students through motivational messages. Volunteers play a crucial role in this initiative by creating personalized cards with uplifting and encouraging messages. These messages are meant to inspire and motivate the students, reminding them of their potential and the value of their education.

- Once the cards are created, the Right To Live team takes care of printing them and ensuring that each student receives a hard copy of the card. This physical exchange of cards adds a personal touch and makes the experience more meaningful for the students.
- Cisco has been a continued partner in supporting this employee-engaging event. By joining forces with Right To Live, Cisco and its employees contribute to the creation of a supportive and encouraging environment for the students, fostering their self-belief and confidence.

Engaging with children at government school

The volunteers spent time in person with the children, engaging in various activities to impart unique skills, storytelling sessions, and delivering motivational speeches. These interactions aim to inspire, educate, and uplift the children, providing them with valuable experiences and knowledge beyond their regular curriculum.

- Employees from Microsoft, Mckinsey, and Opteamix joined hands with Right To Live for this volunteering activity. By sharing their expertise, skills, and experiences, these volunteers contribute to the holistic development of the children, fostering a sense of confidence, motivation, and a broader perspective.



Toy & Stationery Distribution

Well-designed educational toys and games can be extremely beneficial in improving the understanding of a child.

- Right To Live, using the employee donation from McKinsey and Company, conducted a toy donation drive, at the Chandra English High School, Rajajinagar, Bengaluru.





Preparation of learning models

The preparation of learning models is an important volunteering activity conducted by the Right To Live team in collaboration with Cisco. During this event, volunteers from Cisco and the Right To Live team came together to create math, science, and geography models that can be used as teaching aids in government schools.

The volunteers, with their expertise and creativity, worked on designing and building these models, ensuring they are engaging, interactive, and aligned with the curriculum. This activity not only enhances the volunteers' skills and knowledge but also provides them with a hands-on experience of contributing to the education sector and making a difference in the lives of students.

Corporate Team Visits to Bagepalli

Corporate volunteering programs through rural immersion are an impactful initiative undertaken by corporates such as BYJU'S, NASDAQ, Aditi Consulting, and Blackhawk Network in collaboration with Right to Live. These programs involve employees visiting Bagepalli, a rural area in Chikkaballapur district, located on the outskirts of Bengaluru.

The purpose of these programs is to provide employees with a firsthand experience of the realities faced by underserved communities and the challenges in rural education. By immersing themselves in the local environment, employees gain a deeper understanding of the socio-economic conditions and educational infrastructure in these areas.

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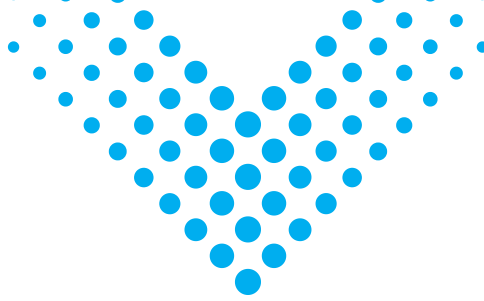
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
