KEY ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN: 2018 - 2019

Kote Foundation mainly focuses on three major areas i.e. Health, Education and Basic Infrastructure.

Health Care

Right To Live is a technology platform, that has been built to support the underprivileged and help them gain access to healthcare at an affordable cost. Under the Right To Live initiative, we take up the responsibility for patient care by raising donations using the Right To Live portal.

Patients Screening and Assessment

As part of the need assessment, we collect and assess the financial and medical condition of the patient. This is carried out by employing one out of the following methods - verifying the BPL card of the patients, Family Income certificate, Medical estimate and case history provided by the hospital or doctor, and wherever necessary, conduct home visits to the patients.

This activity is carried out by a trained professional. After verifying the case history, the professional presents the case to the managing committee. The committee takes it into consideration and comes to a decision to take up the case or not. Once approved, we upload the information of the beneficiary on the Right To Live website.

Patients who are in need of medical care and support are referred by partner organizations, individuals, hospitals, and corporates.

EDUCATION SUPPORT

Scholarship programs

Right To Live extends its support in the field of Education by identifying students hailing from underprivileged socio-economic background who have an innate passion to continue their studies. The trust is then informed of our recommendations and extends financial support to these children.

During the year 2018-2019, we have supported the education of 18 children, out of which 4 were males and 12 females. Most of them have passed their second PUC and have opted for Engineering and other courses.

E- Learning at Government Schools

Right To Live has introduced an e-learning facility at Government schools in partnership with content provided by BYJU'S Learning App and Children's Love Castle Trust (CLT India). This program has transformed the way education is imparted in Government schools, the most complex concepts are simplified and made interesting, thus transforming learning from a theoretical process into a more visual and contextual one.

Our holistic solution includes:

- Identifying deserving schools.
- Improving the quality of classroom education through digital content.
- Providing digital content both in regional language Kannada as well as in English.
- Providing a detailed teacher training program to equip teachers with the knowledge and expertise required to deliver quality and effective teaching using digital tools.
- Collecting feedback from students and the teachers and giving it to content providers to tailor content suitable for Government schools.
- Dedicated school coordinators to ensure smooth implementation, monitor the usage of the E-Learning facility and to measure the impact by conducting tests at regular intervals.

In January 2018 we piloted the program in 4 government schools in Bangalore. The program was a huge success and we received an overwhelming response from both students and teachers. On witnessing the success of this program, we decided to expand this high-quality learning facility to more and more government schools. In the month of December 2018, we implemented this high-quality e-learning facility to 13 new schools in Anekal Taluk.

Today our revolutionary e-learning program is active in 25 schools benefitting more than 4000 students daily!

BASIC INFRASTRUCTURE SUPPORT- VILLAGE ADOPTION

About the Village:

Hosahalli Grama Panchayat is located among scenic hillocks in Doddaballapura Taluk in Bengaluru Rural District. It has a total of 21 villages and covers an approximate area of 5960 hectares. The total population is around 9572 (as per 2011 census). The primary occupation is agriculture, with a number of farmers growing banana, arecanut, flowers and other crops. This village has also retained traditional potters and weavers.

Famous landmarks near Hosahalli include - Makalidurga Hillock, Ghati Subramanya Temple, etc.

Right To Live has partnered with Mythri Speaks to implement the following activities:

Activities undertaken:

- **Swachh Bharath:** Community toilet construction
- **Education:** E-Learning in 2 Government Schools & makeover of 2 Government Schools
- **Drinking Water:** Community R.O. Plant for 2 villages
- **Village Volunteering:** Volunteering activities at the village
- **Environment:** De-weeding of an 84 acre lake





Kerala Flood Relief

Kerala was going through the worst monsoon fury in 100 years. The floods paralyzed the normal life of millions of people. Lakhs have been affected and thousands of victims were in desperate need of relief supplies. This campaign was undertaken to mobilize resources for the relief efforts in Pathanamthitta Districts in coordination with local doctors and medical staff at the camps.

Our heartfelt thanks to all donors who have donated towards this campaign. We were able to dispatch medicines worth INR 10,248 which was distributed to the flood victims at refugee camps in Pathanamthitta district.



FLOOD RELIEF

Kodagu Rehabilitation Campaign

With kind donations received from donors, along with a matching grant from Opteamix (a US-based IT company), we were able to raise a total of INR 2,60,000 towards aiding victims of the recent Kodagu floods.

We received multiple appeals from people/organizations in Kodagu for support and after a thorough evaluation, we zeroed in on a request put in by Smt D Chenamma PU College, Madapur.

Right To Live, in association with Rotary Misty Hills, Madikeri, organized a 'Scholarship Distribution Event' at Smt D Chenamma PU College Madapura, to offer financial support to 11 female and 11 male students whose lives were severely affected by the floods.

- We have given scholarships of INR. 10,000/- each to all the 22 students.
- In addition to this, we will also be extending our support to a 9-year old girl – Ishana, who lost her parents and her house due to floods.

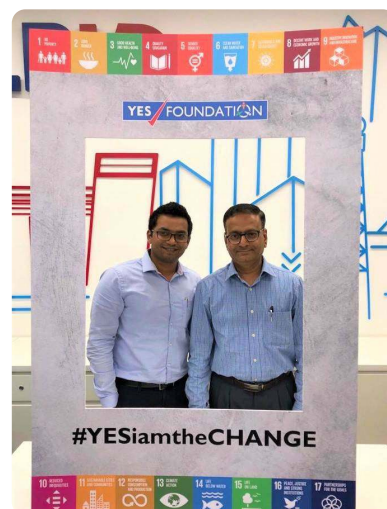

January 2019

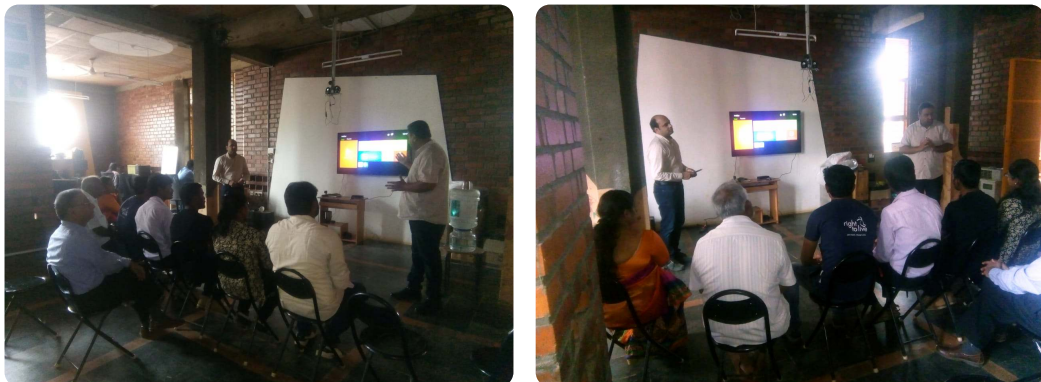
